Nobel Peace Prize 2023

Learn about Narges Mohammadi, an advocate for women's rights and human freedoms in Iran. She was honored (1) with the Nobel Peace Prize in 2023 for her tireless efforts. Despite facing imprisonment (2) and harsh sentences, Mohammadi remained committed to her cause. Since 2003, she has been involved with the Defenders of Human Rights Center, where she helped imprisoned activists and campaigned (3) against injustices (4). Mohammadi's struggle for freedom came with a heavy price. She was arrested multiple times and sentenced to prison and lashes. Even while in captivity, she continued to fight against the Iranian regime. Her story is one of courage (5) and resilience (6), inspiring others to strive for democracy (7), freedom, and equality (8).
