Writing a good story can be fun and exciting! Here's a simple guide to help you get started:

- 1. Find Inspiration (1): Think of different ideas and pick one to turn into a story.
- Create Characters: Make detailed profiles for your characters with clear reasons for what they do.
- 3. **Pick a <u>Setting (2)</u>:** Choose a place for your story that fits well with what happens and affects how characters act.
- 4. **Plan Your Plot:** Make a plan of what will happen in your story to help you write it.
- 5. Choose Your Point of View (3): Decide if you want to tell the story from one person's view or from outside.

Now, let's write your story:

- 1. **Start Your Story:** Introduce your characters and where they are so people can start to <u>imagine (4)</u> the story.
- Add a Problem: Make something happen that will make the story interesting and keep people reading.
- 3. **Make Things <u>Tough (5)</u>**: Add more problems for your characters to deal with as they try to <u>solve(7)</u> the main one.
- 4. **Build Up to a Big Moment**: Reach the most exciting part of your story where something important (8) happens.
- 5. **Wrap Things Up:** Finish your story by tying up any <u>loose ends (9)</u> and giving it a <u>satisfying (10)</u> ending.

By following these steps, you can write a story that people will enjoy reading.
